Who are we at the Academic Support Center (ASC)?

We are an internationally certified tutoring program dedicated to quality education here at Tunxis Community College. Our professional and peer tutors go through an extensive training program designed by the College Reading and Learning Association. At the ASC, our tutors are ready, willing, and able to help you with your classes.

We welcome you to take advantage of this great program. We offer both individual and group tutoring, but best of all, we offer it for FREE.

Every semester, we offer tutoring for developmental math and English, and English as a Second Language. Depending on tutor availability, we also provide tutoring for many other academic classes. We try our best to secure tutors for most courses offered at Tunxis.

How do I sign up for a tutor?

To reserve yourself a tutoring session, we recommend that you schedule an appointment. However, tutors may be available on a walk-in basis as well. To get started, all you need is a Tunxis ID card or proof of enrollment.

With your Tunxis ID, you can sign up for as many as two 45-minute sessions per week for each class. And if you need more tutoring time than that, you may come in as a “walk-in” up to five times a week.

Whether you have an appointment or not, make sure you check in with the front desk before meeting with your tutor.

Tutoring sessions are student centered. You will get the most out of your session if you come prepared with all related course materials and specific course questions or problems.

How do I become a tutor?

We hire new peer tutors every semester. We look for students who are strong in reading, writing, math, and English as a Second Language.

If you're interested in becoming a tutor, please read the requirements below:

- You must be a current Tunxis student having completed a minimum of 12 credits at Tunxis.
- You need an overall GPA of 3.0 or better, and at least a B in the course(s) you want to tutor.
- You are available to tutor between 4 and 20 hours each week, and are available to participate in 5-10 hours of tutor training each semester.
- You have good communication skills, a high level of patience, and a sincere desire to help others.

If this sounds like you, come to the ASC to apply.
