*For recipients enrolled in a community college, the award is renewable, with a maximum of three award years, for students who maintain a grade point average of 3.0 or better. If the student earns a certificate or associate's degree within three years, the award may continue for an additional two years to pursue a bachelor's degree at a four-year public college or university in Connecticut as long as the student maintains a grade point average of 3.0 or better, and, when required, declares a major in the field of science, medicine, engineering or technology.*
