

FACT SHEET



STUDENTS

- Serves more than 7,500 credit and 4,000 non-credit students each year from the Farmington Valley and beyond.
- 69% of the credit students come from primary service areas of Avon, Berlin, Bristol, Burlington, Farmington, New Britain, Plainville, Plymouth/Terryville, Simsbury, Southington, and Wolcott.
- Fall 2019: 3,781 students (credit only); 2,265 (full-time equivalent).
- Average age: 25; 56% women, 44% men.
- TXCC serves “returning students” with associate’s, bachelor’s, master’s and doctoral degrees.
- Approximately 42% students are minorities.
- Tunxis is one of the largest providers of workforce training programs within the Connecticut community college system. The Division of Workforce Development & Continuing Education serves over 4,000 non-credit students.

FACULTY & STAFF

- Faculty: 58 full-time with master’s or doctoral degrees; 233 part-time.

DEGREES & CERTIFICATES

- 17,335 credit degrees and certificates awarded since 1972 to over 14,083 graduates.
- More than 6,000 non-credit certificates awarded since 2001.
- Over 60 associate degrees & certificates are offered.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Associate of Arts and Associate of Science Degrees in disciplines, such as Business, Computer Information Systems, Criminal Justice, Early Childhood Education, Energy Management, Engineering Science, General Studies, Graphic Design, Human Services, Liberal Arts and Sciences, Pathway to Teaching Careers, Technology Studies, and Visual Fine Arts.
- TXCC also offers 27 certificate programs including certificates in Advanced Manufacturing Technology.
- Non-credit certificate programs such as Caregiver Training, Certified Medical Administrative Assistant, Certified Nurse Aide, Certified Patient Care Technician, Certified Pharmacy Technician, Certified Phlebotomy Technician, Certified Sterile Processing Technician, CPR, EKG + Pulse Oximetry Skills, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Massage Therapy, Registered Medical Assistant, Veterinary Assistant are offered through Continuing Education.

TRANSFER

- CSU’s Transfer Ticket Degrees are discipline pathways for our students to complete degree programs that transfer to Connecticut State Universities.
- Guaranteed Admission Program with UConn.
- Dual Admission Program with Connecticut State Universities.
- Pathways to Teaching with Central Connecticut State University.
- TXCC graduates have successfully transferred to over 100 public and private universities, both in Connecticut and throughout the country.

FINANCIAL AID & BUDGET

- Tuition and Fees: \$2,278 for full-time, in-state student per semester.
- Awarded more than \$8.6 million in federal, state, institution, and private aid to students. This includes a mix of merit-based and need-based aid, comprising grants, loans, scholarships and work-study opportunities.
- Annual Budget: \$37.5 million.

FACILITIES, PROGRAMS, SPECIAL EVENTS AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

- Tunxis@ Bristol, the satellite facility, enables Tunxis to expand educational and training opportunities to serve the community.
- Tunxis Library opens to the public, Academic Success Center, bookstore, college career pathways, career services, customized training for business, personal interest courses (non-credit), Student Government Association, and student clubs.
