A full refund of TUITION EXTENSION FEE ONLY will be issued if an official (written) course withdrawal request is received in the Records Office one business day prior to the first scheduled class.

NO REFUND will be given after classes have started, except in cases of serious illness or **EXTRAORDINARY** circumstances. In such cases, at the discretion of the College, a refund (partial or full) may be given until onethird of the class has met.

Refunds will not be granted based on unmet prerequisites.
